Don't let worry and care depress you or brush your joy away, but arise and give thanks to God above for His love and another "blest day."

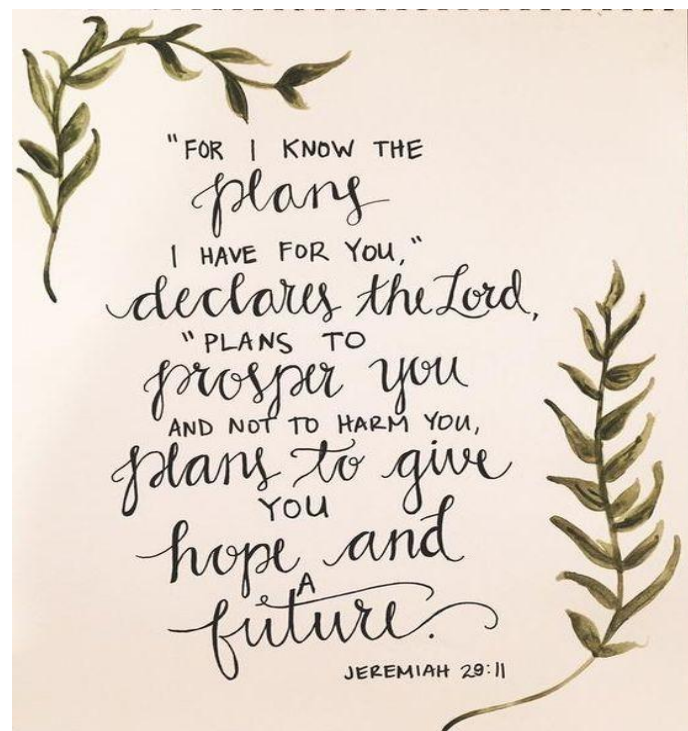
