On-Site Services Beginning October 11, 2020

It is with joy and thanksgiving that the Elders announce resumption of on-site worship services at the Woodbridge church of Christ beginning Sunday, October 11, 2020. We will also continue to Live Stream our worship service on our YouTube channel and Facebook page.

Thank you for your cooperation and patience as we work through this process. Outlined below are some of the things to expect.

- (1) **Worship Services:** One morning worship services will be offered. 10:30 A.M.
- (2) **Masks:** We ask that everyone wear a mask while in the building. Please bring a mask from home. A limited number will be on hand for those that do not. The exceptions to these standards are:
 - (a) Children under the age of 2 (per CDC suggestions). There may be children older than this refusing to wear a mask. We understand! Please keep those around you in mind as you work with your little ones; and
 - (b) Men when they are making any type of announcement, leading prayer, presenting the lesson, etc. from the podium. (There will only be one man at a time at the podium, the podium will be cleaned between each person using the podium).
- (3) **Entry to the Building:** There will be one of the men at the front door using a Non-Contact Forehead Thermometer to check for fevers before entering. After this is done you will be directed to enter the building. Please enter through the front main doors of the foyer and proceed directly to your seat. All other doors should not be used. There will be someone available in the foyer if you need assistance.
- (4) **Seating:** Seating is allowed in any pew which has not been taped off with purple tape. We ask that you keep 6ft. social distancing in mind. All members of the same family will need to sit together.

(5) Song Service: Songs will be displayed on the screens. Please remember to wear your mask during the song service. We realize wearing a mask can be a challenge while singing. It may help your breathing to sing softly. You will notice that all Bibles, song books, visitor cards and pens have been removed temporarily.

(6) Lord's Supper: The bread and fruit of the vine will be available for you to pick up as you enter the door of the auditorium. Masks may be removed during the taking of the Lord's Supper.

(7) Contribution: There will be an opportunity to give your contribution at the tables at the entrance of the auditorium as you leave after the closing prayer.

(8) Training room: The training room will only be open for the purpose of changing diapers and other infant related needs.

(9) Bathrooms: Please use bathrooms only if completely necessary.

(10) Who Should Consider Not Attending, but not required (according to CDC guidelines):

(a) Those 65 & older; and

(b) Those with serious medical conditions not under control such as, lung disease, asthma, heart issues and compromised immune systems.

(c) We do ask if you have had a temperature, persistent cough, or any type of illness in the last 14 days please stay home and worship online.

(11) Exiting after Services: Specific instructions will be given in the closing announcements. You will be directed to exit by row starting from the back of the auditorium. Please do not congregate in the foyer, porch area or sidewalks when you leave. Please respect everyone's personal space and do not hug, shake hands or approach anyone to close in the parking lot.

(12) A.M. Bible Classes, P.M. Worship & Mid-Week Bible Study: These will be restored as soon as practicable. Brother Maiwald will continue to have his Wednesday night Bible class live streamed on Facebook.

(13) Areas closed: All Classrooms, Training Room * (8), Offices, Kitchen and Water Fountains.

We realize that most, if not all, of what has been outlined above is a new experience for all of us. This may not have been what you were expecting but we have the best interest for everyone's health and safety. We are very thankful for the opportunity to assemble again as a church family. We look forward to the day when we can return to normal services.
