

Sometimes Silence is Golden

The Bible tells us plainly in James 3:1-12 that the tongue is a little member of the body that boasts of great things. It is also described as a fire, a world of iniquity, a defiler of the body, untamable, an unruly evil, and full of deadly poison. Because the tongue is so dangerous, it is important that we measure our words. Our words should be few (Proverbs 10:19). Twenty instances in which we ought to keep our mouths closed include the following:

1. In the heat of anger (Proverbs 14:17).
2. When we don't have all the facts (Proverbs 18:13).
3. When we haven't verified the story (Deuteronomy 17:6).
4. If our words will offend a weaker person (1 Corinthians 8:11).
5. When it is time to listen (Proverbs 13:1).
6. When we are tempted to make light of holy things (Ecclesiastes 5:2).
7. When we are about to joke about sin (Proverbs 14:9).
8. If we would be ashamed of our words later (Proverbs 8:8).
9. If our words would convey the wrong impression (Proverbs 17:17).
10. If the issue is none of our business (2 Thessalonians 3:11).
11. If we are tempted to tell a lie (Proverbs 4:24).
12. If our words will damage someone else's reputation (Proverbs 16:27).
13. If our words will damage a friendship (Proverbs 16:28).
14. When we are feeling critical (James 3:9).
15. If we can't say it without screaming it (Ephesians 4:31).
16. If our words will be a poor reflection of the Lord (1 Peter 2:21-23).
17. If we might have to eat our words later (Proverbs 18:21).
18. If we have already said it more than one time (Proverbs 19:13).
19. When we are tempted to flatter a wicked person (Proverbs 24:24).
20. If we are supposed to be working instead (Proverbs 14:23).— HousetoHouse.com
