- Be thankful for weariness and aching muscles at the end of the day ... it means you have been productive.

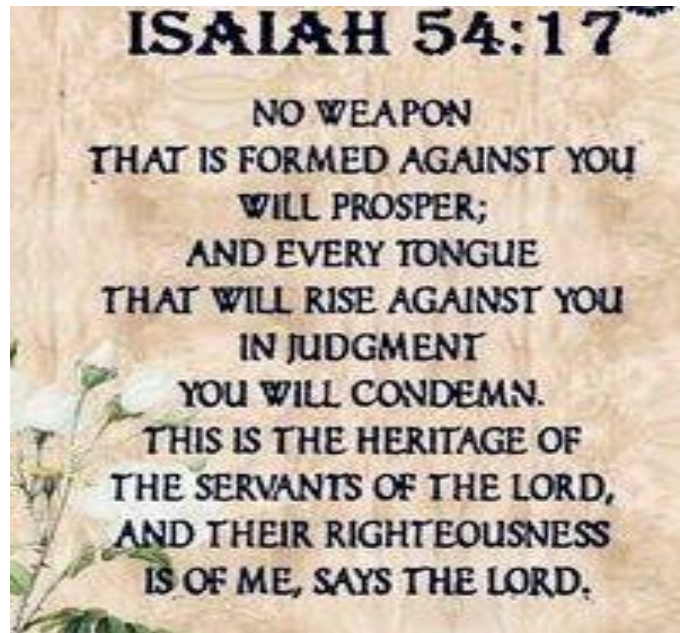
